INSIGHTS TO THE HOUSTON VEHICLE MARKET

Houston Region Total Sales were down in Q4-2023 at 83,587 units compared to Q3-2023 at 87,415 units sold and up compared to Q4-2022 at 73,011 units.

The Houston Region Retail Sales for Q4-2023 were down at 73,302 units compared to Q32023 at 78,939 units, and up with 67,014 units sold in Q42022.

The Retail Auto Segment sold 15,872 units in Q4-2023 for the Houston Region, down compared to Q3-2023 with 17,863 units sold and up from 15,057 units sold in Q4-2022.

The Retail Truck/SUV Segment sold 57,430 units for Q4-2023, this was down compared to Q3-2023 with 61,076 units sold and up from Q4-2022 with 51,957 units sold.

## LOOKING AHEAD

Sometimes, when "Looking Ahead", one must look where we've been. Since tracking new vehicle sales in the Houston Region, 2023 saw the $4^{\text {th }}$ best year in new vehicle sales for the Houston Region at 356,437 vehicles sold, eclipsing 2022 with 310,907 units sold, while 2021 had 274,604 units, compared to 248,034 units in 2020 \& 292,606 units for 2019. There were 303,385 units in 2018, 290,354 units in 2017 \& 299, 461 units in 2016. We must look back to years before \& after the "Great Recession": 2007 at 358, 770, 2014 at 373,998 \& 2015 at 376,481 units. With the past few years behind \& consumer confidence high, 2024 is looking to be even better than 2023, perhaps surpassing the all-time high of 2015. Let's see what lies ahead!

The 12 month average for the Auto Segment Retail Market Share was 21.7\%.

The 12 month average for the Truck/SUV Retail Market Share was high at $78.3 \%$.

The Q4-2023 Auto Segment Retail Market Share decreased from $21.6 \%$ compared to Q3-2023 at 22.6\%. Q4-2023 was down compared to Q4-2022 at 22.5\% for the Houston Region.


The Q4-2023 Truck/SUV Retail Market Share was up at 78.4\% compared to Q3-2023 of 77.4\% and up from Q4-2022 at 77.5\%.


The Retail Sales for the Auto Segment sold 68,050 units in 2023 versus 62,817 units in 2022, with a significant decrease from 130,627 units in 2014.

The Retail Sales for the Truck/SUV Segment sold 245,456 in 2023 versus 224,389 units in 2022 with a significant increase from 188,733 units sold in 2014.

The 12-Month Rolling Total Sales for Autos in the Houston

Region continues to fluctuate month to month.

The Truck/SUV became the "Family Car" in 1998, sidelining the station wagon $\&$ the minivan.

The 12-Month Rolling Total Sales for 2023 ended at 356,437 in that sales exceeded the forecasted units sold of 310,000 in the Houston Region.

'Hurricane Harvey’, ‘The Pandemic’ and 'The Supply Chain Issues’ were all major events for the US \& the Houston Region. Each of these events have been smoothed out on the 12-month Rolling Chart for Houston Total Sales. In comparison, ‘The 2009 Recession’ was \& is still a very prominent data point.

The Average Fleet Sales Market Share for the last 12

Months was 12.0\%.

DEC 2023 FLEET SALES MARKET SHARE UP SLIGHTLY COMPARED TO NOV 2023


Fleet Sales Market Share was up at 12.3\% for Q4-2023 compared to $9.8 \%$ in Q3-2023 and up from Q4-2022 at 8.2\%. Fleet Sales can be an indicator of general business conditions and confidence. Fleet Sales include rental vehicles and third party leases.


The Average Retail Sales Price for Q4-2023 was \$51,221 down compared to Q3-2023 at \$51,517 and down compared to Q4-2022 at $\$ 52,040$. Retail Sales Prices are vehicles sold at franchised dealerships.

In 2023-YTD, Electric (EV), Hybrid \& Plug-in Hybrids (PHEV) Vehicles account for 17.8\% Of The Market Share

## MOTORIST ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MAP)

The Motorist Assistance Program (MAP) has a significant impact on every Houston motorist, providing crucial support during times of distress. Being stranded on a freeway can be a daunting and potentially hazardous situation, but the arrival of a MAP patrol vehicle brings a sense of relief and reassurance.

Originally launched in 1986 with two service vans, the MAP fleet has expanded to include eighteen specially-equipped vehicles operated by Harris County Sheriff's deputies. These dedicated officers traverse Hou-ston-area freeways tirelessly, covering hundreds of miles each weekday, around the clock. Their primary objective is to identify motorists in need of basic roadside assistance, such as fuel or other essential services. By promptly and safely attending to these motorists, the MAP deputies contribute to reducing traffic congestion.
Since the MAP program's inception, HADA has donated and placed more than 120 new vehicles into service and nearly 1 million drivers have been assisted. The program is administered by the Harris County Sheriff's Department and funded by METRO, Texas Department of Transportation, City of Houston, Houston TranStar and HADA. \#
