
# Q2-2023 Total Sales Were Up Compared To Q1-2023 & Q2-2022

Houston Region Total Sales were up in Q2-2023 at 93,922 units compared to Q1-2023 at 92,749 units sold and up compared to Q2-2022 at 88,569 units.

The Houston Region Retail Sales for Q2-2023 were down at 80,015 units compared to Q1-2023 at 81,250 units, and down with 80,586 units sold in Q2-2022.

The Retail Auto Segment sold 17,345 units in Q2-2023 for the Houston Region, up compared to Q1-2023 with 16,970 units sold and down from 17,596 units sold in Q2-2022.


The Retail Truck/SUV Segment sold 62,670 units for Q2-2023, this was down

HOUSTON REGION RETAIL SALES BY MONTH - 2021 THRU 2023



### **LOOKING AHEAD**


After a rip-roaring first quarter of 2023, the vehicle-market in the Houston Region looks to be settling...somewhat. Total Sales are still red hot for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, being buoyed by strong Fleet Sales. The average Retail Sales Price has cooled and leveled out after unprecedented price increase after price increase, which is good news for consumers and dealership foot/online traffic. As 2023 USNational Sales make a comeback after stalling for the last 3 years, 2023 Houston Regional Sales still outpace sales nationally. While we make our way through hot Texas summer months, the Houston Region's vehicle sales show no signs of cooling down.

# Combined Retail Vehicle Sales for the Last 12-Months & Breakout of Cars & Trucks/SUVs



The Retail Auto Segment sold 17,345 units in Q2-2023 which was up compared to Q1-2023 with 16,970 units sold and but down from 17,596 units sold in Q2-2022. The Retail Truck/SUV Segment sold 62,670 units for Q2-2023. This was down compared to Q1-2023 with 64,280 units sold and down from Q2-2022 with 62,990 units sold.

# Houston Region Sales 12-Month Rolling Chart for Cars, Trucks/SUVs and Total Vehicles



For vehicles sold in the Houston Region, the 12-Month Rolling Total Sales at the end of Q2-2023 were 338,518 units sold. In comparison the 12-Month Rolling Total Sales at the end of Q1-2023 were 333,165 units and the 12-Month Rolling Total Sales at the end of Q2-2022 were 279,430 units.





# Q2-2023 Retail Auto Market Share Up From Q1-2023



The Q2-2023 Auto Segment Retail Market Share increased from 21.7% compared to Q1-2023 at 20.9%. Q2-2023 was down slightly compared to Q2-2022 at 21.8% for the Houston Region.

The Q2-2023 Truck/SUV Retail Market Share was down at 78.3% compared to Q1-2023 of 79.1% and slightly up from Q2-2022 at 78.2%.


The 12 month (Jul 22 -Jun 23) average for the Truck/SUV Retail Market Share was high at 78.3%.



## Q2-2023 Fleet Sales Market Share Increased From the Previous Quarter & Previous Year



Fleet Sales Market Share was up at 14.8% for Q2-2023 compared to 12.3% in Q1-2023 and up from Q2-2022 at 9.0%. Fleet Sales can be an indicator of general business conditions and confidence. Fleet Sales include rental vehicles and third party leases.

### **Average Retail Sales Price For Q2-2023**



The Average Retail Sales Price for Q2-2023 was \$52,040 down compared to Q1-2023 at \$52,562 and up compared to Q2-2022 at \$49,908. Retail Sales Prices are vehicles sold at franchised dealerships.

The Average (JUL 22-JUN 23) Fleet Sales Market Share for the last 12 Months was 10.5%.

The record breaking hot streak of the Average Retail Price cools for Q2-2023.



## **Highlighted Member Service**

#### **MOTORIST ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MAP)**

The Motorist Assistance Program (MAP) has a significant impact on every Houston motorist, providing crucial support during times of distress. Being stranded on a freeway can be a daunting and potentially hazardous situation, but the arrival of a MAP patrol vehicle brings a sense of relief and reassurance.

Originally launched in 1986 with two service vans, the MAP fleet has expanded to include eighteen specially-equipped vehicles operated by Harris County Sheriff's deputies. These dedicated officers traverse Houston-area freeways tirelessly, covering hundreds of miles each weekday, around the clock. Their primary objective is to identify motorists in need of basic roadside assistance, such as fuel or other essential services. By promptly and safely attending to these motorists, the MAP deputies contribute to reducing traffic congestion.

Since the MAP program's inception, HADA has donated and placed more than 120 new vehicles into service and nearly 1 million drivers have been assisted. The program is administered by the Harris County Sheriff's Department and funded by METRO, Texas Department of Transportation, City of Houston, Houston TranStar and HADA. #
